Job purpose

Groom fields for Middle School Baseball and Softball as well as Adult Softball in Spring/Summer/Fall.

Duties and responsibilities

Daily responsibilities and duties may include but are not limited to:

- Must drive NORA pickup truck or similar vehicle that can tow equipment on fields
- Obtain equipment at NORA Office
- Travel to local schools/fields
- Complete a training on proper ways to groom and maintain baseball/softball fields
- Groom infields based on upcoming usage
- Line fields using NORA equipment
- Report any problems to Recreation Program Coordinator
- Determine when regular maintenance needs to be done vs. more in depth field grooming

Qualifications

Applicants for this position must meet the following criteria:

- At least 16 years of age
- Access to reliable transportation
- Ability to work independently
- Demonstrated ability to work with adults in a positive manner
- Strong Communication skills between players, groups and staff are essential
- Driver's license with clean driving record
- Knowledge of baseball/softball fields and grooming a plus but not required

Working conditions

This job will be outdoors at softball and baseball fields. Must be prepared to work quickly and efficiently while maintaining standards expected by NORA, Leagues and Municipalities. Exposure to heat, wind, dust, dirt, grass, water and chalk are regular in this position.

Physical requirements

You will be required to be outdoors, may be doing repetitive motions with hands, arms, fingers, legs. Must be able to lift 50-75 lbs to load and unload equipment as well as groom fields. Must be able to climb in and out of a pickup truck and walk around baseball/softball fields.
